

Emirates Airline Dubai Rugby Sevens 2011 Ticket Terms and Conditions

- These terms and conditions govern the relationship between the spectator/ticket holder and organiser (Promoseven Sports Marketing) with regard to attendance at the Emirates Airline Dubai Rugby Sevens ('Tournament'). The issuance, use or attempted use of this ticket binds the ticket holder to these terms and conditions.
- Once purchased, tickets are non-refundable. Tickets may not be re-sold or transferred for profit by anyone other than the Organiser. On any unauthorized re-sale or transfer, this ticket shall become null and void and the ticket holder will be refused entry or ejected from the venue. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel any ticket advertised with the intent of reselling for profit or commercial gain.
- General Admission
 - Thursday 1st December is free entry to the Tournament.
 - Friday 2nd and Saturday 3rd December - Tickets apply.
 - Children under 12 years will be admitted free to the general admission area only.
 - Only children under 3 years will be admitted free to the reserved seating / VIP area.
 - Photo identification for proof of age may be required.
 - The family area (no alcohol permitted) is available in the BP Stand for parents and children only.
- Early arrival is recommended and the Organiser accepts no responsibility for late arrival.
- No person shall breach or infringe the rights of any sponsors, suppliers, broadcasters or other parties commercially associated with the Tournament, nor conduct unauthorized promotions or other commercial activity.
- All ticket holders must comply with all applicable Health and Safety laws / regulations in force together with the venue rules.
- No food or drink may be brought into the venue and will be confiscated by security at the entrance to the venue.
- All persons and bags will be subject to search when entering the venue and prohibited and dangerous items will be confiscated, including, but not limited to: guns, replica guns, knives or weapons of any sort; explosives; aerosol containers; pointed or sharp objects; razors, box cutters or tools of any kind.
- Underage drinking will not be permitted at the venue. Photo identification for proof of age will be required.
- Any person attending the Tournament expressly acknowledges that it is a public event and in this regard agrees that his/her image may be broadcast for no consideration and more generally be exploited by any means and on any media, throughout the entire world and for the duration of the exploitation of this and future Tournaments, and waives in advance all rights and actions seeking to oppose this exploitation. Spectators' use of their own recordings of the Tournament is strictly limited to personal use only.
- The Organiser reserves the right to cancel the Tournament in whole or in part without notice, for any reason. In such cases a refund or partial refund may be given at the Organiser's discretion, but is not guaranteed.
- The Organiser shall accept no liability for bodily injury, illness or death of any visitor (including yourself) and / or loss of or damage to personal effects arising out of or in connection with the Tournament, save where the same results from the negligence on the part of employees of the Organiser whilst acting within the scope of their employment.
- The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry or service to, or expel any person whose behaviour is deemed in the sole discretion of the Organiser to be unsuitable.
- These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of, and applicable in, the emirate of Dubai.
